

BAGC Birthday Party Policies

Blue Angels Gymnastics Club

A clear guide for booking, hosting, and enjoying a safe, fun BAGC birthday party.

Party Options & Pricing

Party Type	Base Price	Additional Athletes
Gymnastics Party	\$200 - up to 10 athletes	\$10 per additional athlete
Nerf Party	\$275 - up to 10 athletes	\$12 per additional athlete

- Each party includes 60 minutes of gym time and 30 minutes at party tables.
- A BAGC party coach is included to lead activities.
- Only one party is booked per time slot, giving your group access to the entire gym.
- Nerf parties include BAGC-provided Nerf blasters, foam darts, and game equipment.

Optional Add-Ons

- Glow in the Dark Party: \$40 plus \$2 per additional athlete. BAGC provides glow sticks, necklaces, bracelets, and related glow items, and part of gym time includes games in the dark.
- Goodie Bags: \$5 per athlete. Each bag includes candy and an Open Gym pass.

Booking & Payment

- Birthday parties must be reserved through the BAGC online registration platform.
- Party availability is based on BAGC staffing and facility availability.
- The party reservation is not guaranteed until registration and required deposit (\$100) are completed.
- Final participant counts and any add-ons must be confirmed 2 weeks before the party so BAGC can prepare appropriately.

Arrival, Setup & Party Timing

- Families should arrive no earlier than 20 minutes prior to party start time and check in with BAGC staff before decorating or bringing guests into the party area.
- The scheduled party time includes 60 minutes in the gym followed by 30 minutes at the party tables.
- To keep parties on schedule, gym time cannot be extended when guests arrive late.
- Guests may enter the gym floor only when directed by the BAGC party coach.

Participant Safety & Attire

- Party participants should wear comfortable, fitted athletic clothing suitable for gymnastics and active play.
- Long hair must be secured away from the face.
- Jewelry, watches, and smart watches must be removed before entering the gym floor.
- Participants will generally be barefoot unless BAGC staff provides different instructions for a specific activity.
- Food, drinks, gum, and candy are not permitted on the gym floor. Water may be kept in designated areas.
- Participants must follow all instructions from BAGC coaches and use equipment only when directed.
- Unsafe, destructive, or disrespectful behavior may result in a participant being removed from gym activities.

Waivers & Guest Information

- Every participant must have a completed BAGC waiver before participating in gym activities.
- The party host is responsible for communicating waiver requirements to invited families before the party.
- Guests who do not have a completed waiver may not participate in gym activities until the required form is completed.

Parent / Guardian Supervision

- BAGC coaches supervise organized gym activities; however, the birthday host remains responsible for invited guests outside of the coached gym portion of the party.
- Parents and guardians must remain in designated viewing or party areas unless invited onto the gym floor by BAGC staff or if they have a participation waiver signed.
- No unregistered children are allowed in the gym area, unless under age 1 and supervised directly (within arms length) by the parent / guardian.

Food, Drinks & Decorations

- Food, cake/cupcakes, and drinks are limited to the designated party table area.
- BAGC has limited fridge and freezer space, though party hosts are welcome to use it.
- No food or drink may be taken onto gymnastics equipment or the gym floor.
- Decorations must be appropriate for a family gymnastics facility and may not damage walls, tables, equipment, or other BAGC property.
- Confetti, glitter, silly string, and similar hard-to-clean decorations are not permitted.
- Open flames are not permitted except for birthday candles used briefly with adult supervision, if allowed by facility rules.
- The party family is responsible for bringing food, serving supplies, and decorations unless BAGC specifically states they are included in the selected package.

Nerf Party Rules

- BAGC provides Nerf blasters, foam darts, and designated game equipment for Nerf parties.
- Participants may use Nerf equipment only during coach-led games and in designated areas.

- Participants must follow all safety instructions, boundaries, and game rules provided by the BAGC party coach.
- Personal Nerf equipment must remain at home.
- BAGC may require protective eyewear for Nerf activities based on the activity setup and equipment used.

Illness, Injury & Accessibility

- Children who are ill, contagious, or unable to safely participate should not attend gym activities.
- Parents should notify BAGC of any injury, medical concern, allergy, or accommodation that may affect safe participation.
- BAGC will make reasonable efforts to support participants who need accommodations when notified in advance.
- Participation may be modified or limited when BAGC staff determines an activity is not safe for a participant.

Cancellation & Rescheduling

- Cancellations made at least 14 days before the party may be transferred once to another available party date or receive an account credit, less a \$30 non-refundable booking fee.
- Cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the party are non-refundable, but BAGC may allow one reschedule for illness or emergency when staffing and availability permit.
- No-shows and same-day cancellations are non-refundable.
- If BAGC must cancel due to weather, facility closure, staffing emergency, or another circumstance within BAGC control, the family may reschedule or receive a full account credit/refund according to BAGC policy.

Facility Care & Cleanup

- Party families and guests are expected to respect BAGC equipment, furnishings, and facility rules.
- Guests should place trash in designated receptacles and leave the party table area reasonably tidy.
- Damage caused by intentional misuse of equipment or property may be charged to the booking family.
- BAGC staff is responsible for resetting gymnastics equipment and putting away tables.

Photography & Privacy

- Families may photograph or record their own child during the party when doing so does not interfere with activities or safety.
- Please avoid intentionally photographing or recording other children without permission from their parent or guardian.
- BAGC staff may enforce additional photography restrictions when necessary for athlete privacy or safety.

Party Host Acknowledgment

By reserving a BAGC birthday party, the booking parent/guardian acknowledges that they have reviewed and agree to follow BAGC Birthday Party Policies, facility rules, participant waiver requirements, and staff

instructions. The booking parent/guardian is responsible for communicating applicable expectations to invited families and guests.

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
